## **Money-Saving Hacks:**

- Book Calgary hotels Sunday-Thursday for 40% savings
- Buy groceries for mountain picnics (Banff restaurants 40% more expensive)

- Download Parks Canada app for offline maps and updates
- Fill gas tank in Calgary (cheaper than mountain towns)

#### **Photography Gold Spots:**

- Peace Bridge at golden hour
- Calgary Central Library spiral staircase
- Lake Louise early morning (reflection shots, no crowds)
- Banff Gondola on clear days (views to Calgary skyline)

#### Weather Survival:

- Chinook winds can change temperature 20°C in hours
- Pack layers ALWAYS, even summer
- Keep emergency kit in car (especially winter)
- Check 511.alberta.ca before mountain driving

#### **Local Secrets:**

warnings/closures

- Kananaskis Nordic Spa > Banff Hot Springs (less crowded, better views)
- River surfing possible in downtown Calgary (Bow River wave)
- +15 skybridge system connects downtown (great for bad weather)
- Calgary Zoo Penguin Walk in winter months

#### **Booking Insider Knowledge:**

- Johnston Canyon parking releases exactly 90 days ahead at 8 AM MT
- Restaurant reservations: Call directly after online booking for upgrades
- Parks Canada shuttle summer: Worth \$8 to avoid Lake Louise parking stress
- Hotel Arts often includes breakfast deals when booking direct
